

Nebraska Center for Nursing Summary

In 2000, the Nebraska Legislature created the Nebraska Center for Nursing. The 16-member board was appointed by the Governor to address the nursing shortage and was charged with developing a strategic plan. For the Board to satisfy its mandate, there was a need for current, comprehensive data about the supply and demand of nurses in Nebraska. Therefore, a comprehensive survey was mailed to all Registered Nurses (RNs), Licensed Practical Nurses (LPNs), and identified employers of RNs and LPNs in Nebraska in the fall of 2000.
